Make plans to be in pleasantly warm and sunny Central Florida in late fall. This year's show continues to build on the momentum started in 2004, and is scheduled for December 3, 4, & 5 at the Central Florida Fairgrounds located on SR 50, just 3.5 miles west of downtown Orlando. FLOREX 2010 will feature 49 dealers from all over North America, occupying 63 booths.

We will announce any society meetings as that information is firmed up in the coming months.

The host hotel for FLOREX 2010 is the Sheraton Orlando Downtown Hotel (1.800.574.3160), located in the city core, it is just 3.5 miles east of the Central Florida Fairgrounds. This is the same hotel as in previous years – with a new name. Make your hotel reservations now. Contract pricing of \$99/night including parking has been set.

FLOREX is the largest World Series of Philately show in the Southeast. The Judge's Critique is scheduled for 2:30 PM Saturday, December 4, 2010. The Awards Presentation and reception for exhibitors and judges will begin at 4:00PM in the exhibit area of the hall.

Once again FLOREX is pleased to have Michael Rogers, Inc. providing auction services for the show. The public auction starts promptly at 5:30, Saturday December 4th and concludes around 9:00 depending on the total number of lots to be cried. There is a great deal of variety for one and all. Additional auction information will be posted as it becomes available in the months to come.

The FLOREX 2010 show cancel and cachet theme will be Boy Scouts. There will be cachets available each day of the show using the 44 cent Boy Scout stamp issued by the USPS in August.

Additional events at this year's show will include; a public auction (contracts to be signed) on Saturday December 4th at 5:30pm), Youth area (with Buckets of Stamps, while supplies last), society meetings, USPS booth, workshops, door prizes, and a grand prize to be awarded at 2:30pm on Sunday December 5, 2010.
