
President's Message



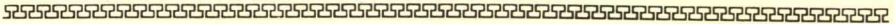

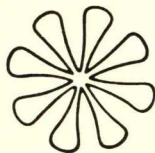
