

OUR SPEAKER, SYLVESTER COLBY



Sylvester Colby, better known to his friends and customers as "SY" has been around the philatelic world for quite a while. In point of fact should you ask him when he started to collect, he would tell you "at the beginning of the Big War" (and he does not mean World War II). Soon enough he became a specialized collector of the 3¢ 1851 and his collection took many prizes when exhibited. In the late '30's Sy turned his avocation into his vocation. He gave up collecting since he did not want to be in competition with his customers.

Sy holds both a Bachelor's and a Master's degree from the University of Virginia. His penchant for research led him into the literature field. Today he is the largest auctioneer of philatelic literature exclusively. His book auctions are eventful occasions. As an auctioneer he is well known, having cried sales from Canada to the Gulf and from Coast to Coast.

For two terms he served as President of the American Stamp Dealers Association and was on their Board of Directors for innumerable years. He is a life member of the A.P.S. and charter member of the Essay Proof Society; the first president of the First Day Cover Society; belongs to the Collectors Club and most of the major societies.




