Five years ago, one of those events that makes us call to mind exactly what we were doing when we first received the news occurred. Seven brave Americans fell to their death as the space shuttle Challenger blew apart in view of millions of Americans.

FLOREX '86 chose to honor America's astronauts with a souvenir cachet and card. The cancellation included an astronaut's helmet and ten stars for the Apollo three and Challenger seven. "To honor and sacrifice" read the salute.

Floridians wanted to remember theme men and women in a special way. The State of Florida authorized a special license plate with a portion of the proceeds to benefit a shrine to be raised at the Kennedy Space Center. This project became a reality this year. If you haven't visited the KSC in several years, you should see the new additions. You will be inspired.

The US Postal Service has issued a booklet of 10 stamps for Stamp Collecting Month. It recognizes the results of deep space exploration as all planets but Pluto have been photographed in a dramatic closeness that a Galileo could never have imagined.

The USPS has teamed with Columbia Studios and their Star Trek movies to promote stamp collecting. It is around this theme that FLOREX '91 salutes America's space achievements. Artist Terry Dietrich has paired the dream with the reality and challenges us to visualize what the future may bring.

We invite you to stop by the registration table and buy a souvenir envelope or card. Pause to remember the sacrifices that have been made and the opportunities that still lay before us.

- 80 (Noncompetitive) Portraits and Pictures: Dollars and Cents. A special one-frame exhibit which brings together the beautiful 19th century engravings on stamps and currency. Conrad C. Bush
- 81-88 Philadontics. A postal view of people, products, and postures of the dental profession. Dr. Alvin Krasne
- 89-96 Russia 1914-15 Charity Issues. The two Charity Issues include essays, proofs, specimens, imperforates and postal usages. Paul Blake
- 97-105 Confederate States of America General Issue. This exhibit contains examples of all the Confederate General Issue stamps and features unique, rare, scarce, and unusual uses. Conrad C. Bush

- 106-111 Judenpost: Jewish Mail under the Nazi Occupation. In their attempt to isolate and destroy the Jews, the Nazis created a Jewish class of mail. This exhibit is distinctively the study of such mail under Nazi occupation. Justin R. Gordon
- 113-122 200 Years of Baltimore Postal History, 1795-1975. This exhibit intends to show representative examples of some postal rates in use during the period 1796-1976. Included are stampless and adhesive covers, wrappers, etc. LeRoy Lipman, Jr.

- 129-133 U. S. Marines in China. A postal history, rates, routes, means, markings, and usages, 1900-1941. Every known key item is shown, many for the first time. Major Ted Bahry
- 134-138 French-Swiss Cantonal Postal Treaty Accounting Mark. Harlan F. Stone
- 139-144 Allied Forces in East Africa, World War I. Military internee and civil censor mail from the East Africa campaign of World War I. Regis Hoffman
- 145-154 Great Britain: The 1887 "Jubilee" Issue and Its Derivatives. Origin, design, production and usage of the issue, including official and colonial overprints. Jeffrey K. Weiss
- 155-159 National Anthems. Commemoratives and philatelic items portraying the national anthems and/or marches of 68 countries. Robert E. Lana

- 192-201 **Cleveland Postal History.** Donald P. Skove  
Covers from 1812-1860's; stampless; "RR"; "PAID"; "REGISTERED"; 5 and 10 cent 1847 covers; Bishops' & Kellogg's locals; patriotics, etc.
- 198-201 **Russian Soviet Federated Socialistic Republic.** The stamps and postal history of the RSFSR. Raymond Pietruszka
- 202-206 **Zepplins: The Portuguese Connection** Phillip E. Parker  
Various Zeppelin covers that were either mailed to, through, or dropped at Portugal and its colonies.

- 207-211 **Soviet Zone Hand Overprints.** Exhibit showing various postal usages of hand overprinted stamps in Soviet Occupation Zone of Germany during the period 24 June--13 July, 1948. Anonymous
