

THE BUREAU ISSUES ASSOCIATION

FLOREX is delighted to welcome President Bill Dunn and the Bureau Issues Association for its annual meeting. For over 60 years, the BIA has served US stamp collectors through its motto "Know Your Country's Stamps."

In 1894 the Bureau of Engraving and Printing began the exclusive production of US stamps. A fad developed collecting plate numbers, sideorgrapher's initials, and other marginal inscriptions. In 1926 a small group of dedicated collectors formed the Philatelic Plate Number Association. Members began publishing articles in the major stamp magazines.

Under the leadership of Hugh M. Southgate, the P.P.N.A. changed its name to the Bureau Issues Association in 1930 and began publishing the <u>Bureau Specialist</u>. Today it is called <u>The United States Specialist</u> and studies all US stamps, not just those of the Bureau. The BIA was incorporated in 1938 as an educational society, and its 2000 members represent a truly international membership.



The BIA is noted for the quality of its philatellic publications such as the <u>Durland Standard Plate Number Catalogue</u>. Currently, there are 21 committees and study groups covering such topics as booklets, precancels, revenues, transportation coils, modern postal history, and plate markings.

Noted editors of the US Specialist include George Brett, Barbara Mueller, Belmont Faries, James Bruns and Chuck Yeager. Other contributing authors include John Hotchner, Steven Rod, Ken Lawrence, Wayne Youngblood, Pat Herst, Bruce Mosher, and Clyde Jennings.

The BIA logo is an engraving done by noted Bureau engraver Thomas Hipschen. It shows a bust of the Statue of Freedom from the US capitol. Congratulations to the BIA for its contributions to the knowledge of US stamps and philately in general.

The Mobile Post Office Society

The Mobile Post Office Society (MPOS) is devoted to the study of transit markings of all types, including railway, highway, and waterway. It is a non-profit corporation of almost 600 members and is APS affillate #64.

The MPOS publishes the <u>Transit Postmark</u>
<u>Collector</u>, a bimonthly which covers new finds
and original research. There are stories from
railway mail clerks, a truly vanishing breed.

A predecessor was The Transit Postmark which was started in the 1930's. In 1950 the National Highway Post Office Society was organized by Virgil Geary. As airplanes and trucks replaced rallway mail cars and automation and sectional centers replaced many mail clerks, these organizations were impelled to join together to cover all transit markings.

In the 1960's, the MPOS was brought to a high level of professionalism under the renouned RR postal historian Charles Towle. Visit the Society table at FLOREX. Dues are \$15, and you can join by writing Andrew C. Koval, Box 502, Bedford Park, IL 60499.






